Seawall Project


All Seawall/Wave wall/Splash walls are complete. Balance of work is to complete Punch List Items.

Basin Inlet structures and elevation adjustments to be completed by January 30, 2020




New Seawall 2020



Tennis Courts

Clubhouse Gym

The Gym is currently one of the most used community amenities in La Peninsula. During the Winter months, with increased people traffic the physical size of the current Gym only allows for several people to comfortably move about to use weights and lifting machines. There have been past discussions to separate the Cardio equipment from the weightlifting dumbbell and weight machines. A proposed idea is to move the existing Library to the Gym location and the Gym over to the Library including the use of the office and storage rooms. We currently have a remote storage building that is air conditioned and can be used. These three rooms would be reconfigured to allow for a much bigger space that will double the size of the current Gym. Proposed floor sketches will be posted in the near future.

Marina Update



All slip decking has been rebuilt and now have new water lines, walkway lights and electric utilities to each slip. All lifts that were dangling in the water have been removed or repaired. The Marina's finances are sound having \$3,000 per slip in reserves and all slip owners are current in their \$1,000/year dues (paid quarterly). A small number of slips are available for sale to only La Peninsula owners (including Twin Dolphins). We have made a number of aesthetic improvements and will continue to make improvements to the marina so the value of the slips to climb toward their original values."
